Mr. Kubierschky's task during this time was to carry out programming with regard to special problems that were becoming an issue within the field of measurement capturing and data processing on UNIX workstations. The following list includes examples of tasks assigned to him:

- access to the in-house weather database as well as further processing and graphical presentation of the data,
- a C and shell interface for standard queries for weather data (Ingres Database),
- building a database for spectroscopic data,
- geometric calculations with regard to shadowing devices,
- calculating the absorption coefficient of windows as a function of angle and wavelength, taking into account interreflection and interference effects on thin layers,
- a graphical user interface for the 3D previewer “Rshow” of the “Radiance” raytracing program.

Mr. Kubierschky carried out the tasks assigned to him very independently. He was very popular with his colleagues, because he was always accessible and willing to lend a helping hand.
